## **Zion Baptist Church Scholarship Information and Guidelines**

### **Objectives**

Zion Baptist Church (ZBC) has an ongoing commitment to the education process, and a desire to recognize the accomplishments of high school graduates who attempt to further their education. This Zion Baptist Church scholarship is given to encourage young high school graduates to pursue the goal of achieving excellence through higher education. We hope that those identified through this scholarship will exemplify not only excellence in academics, but also spiritual leadership in the community as well.

Funds for the scholarships are provided by Zion Baptist Church and are used solely for the graduating seniors of the church to support the youth of ZBC graduating from high school.

### **Award Value**

The amount of the scholarship is based on the availability of funds and the number of applicants applying for scholarships. The number of awards will be determined after all applications are received. All scholarship funds are sent directly to the students for tuition, textbooks, and other fees.

Every applicant that meets the established criteria will receive a scholarship. In addition to fund availability and the number of candidates, the amount will be determined based on the eligibility criteria listed below.

### **Eligibility**

Candidates must meet all the following criteria:

- ◆ You or a family member **MUST** be a member of Zion Baptist Church for at least one (1) year (12 months) prior to the start of the “Graduate Program” sessions. (September 2023)
- ◆ Attend a minimum of 7 out of 10 “Graduate Program” sessions hosted by the Scholarship Committee. Sessions will take place on **Wednesday nights, from September 06 - November 15, 2023.**
- ◆ Be accepted by an accredited school providing education or training certification above the secondary level or military acceptance. (Documentation required)
- ◆ Be a high school graduate within the last 12 months of application.
- ◆ Maintain a grade point average (GPA) at 2.0 or above.
- ◆ **Applications must be received on or before November 15, 2023, before 11:59 p.m. (No late application will be accepted.)**
- ◆ Applicants must submit the following items:
  1. Zion Baptist Church Scholarship application (see enclosed application)
  2. Recommendation form from a high school counselor (see enclosed form)
  3. Letter of recommendation from a community or church leader
  4. An official high school transcript
  5. Personal essay (choose one of the topics and follow all instructions)
  6. Submit the acceptance letter prior to May 26, 2024.

## **Procedure**

Candidates must submit the following:

- Zion Baptist Church Scholarship Application: **Typed, not handwritten.**
- High School Counselor's Recommendation Form
- An official high school transcript sent from the High School Counselor
- Recommendation letter from a community member or church leader: **Typed, not handwritten.**
- An original Personal Essay: **Typed, not handwritten** 12 pt. font Times New Roman

All application materials must be typed, completed in their entirety, and submitted on or before **November 15, 2023 at 11:59 pm** to the Zion Baptist Church Scholarship Committee at [scholarshipcommittee@zbcmarietta.org](mailto:scholarshipcommittee@zbcmarietta.org).

Research may be used or referred to, but the essay must be an original document constructed by the student.

**If any sources are used, all sources must be cited, using APA or MLA format.**

Type a 300 or more-word essay; 12-point font, Times New Roman

Official Transcript (MUST BE SUBMITTED BY COUNSELOR)

Counselor Recommendation Form (MUST BE SUBMITTED BY COUNSELOR)

Must attend 7 out of 10 Wednesday night "Graduate Program" sessions.

Documentation (acceptance letter) is due no later than May 26, 2024.
