

Mother Dr. Mildred Howard Recognized by the Marietta History Center



MESSAGE: PEACE IN TRANSITION

As I think about my time at Zion as the Children & Youth Minister, one of the words I think of is grateful. I have so much gratitude for God in how he chose to use me over these 16 years I served on staff. I am truly grateful for the opportunity afforded to me and all that God did in the season I was serving. God has been so good and I can't thank Him enough.

As I begin my transition from my staff position, another word has been constant in my mind and spirit and that's the word Peace. Peace within my soul as I depart.

Lately, I have come to understand how the Peace of God works and how incredibly valuable is it to have. It's indescribable at times. Peace that surpasses all my understanding. When the timing is in line with God's time, there is Peace. When God gives you the green light after you have waited and been patient to move, there is peace. When you are in God's presence and operating in His will, there is peace.

I have learned that the peace of God is promised to us through the Holy Spirit. John 14:25-27 and John 20:19-22 are verses that Jesus is talking about that peace and how we obtain it. In chapter 14 of John, Jesus is talking to the disciples about this promise of the Holy Spirit. He says, "All this I have spoken while still with you. But the advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you. Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid."

So Jesus is saying, there is a promise coming and that promise is His spirit which is the Holy Spirit which will be our guide, our advocate and it will bring back to memory everything Jesus told us before he died. And it will also bring peace that can only come from Him. Not Worldly peace that is temporary but God-given peace that lasts.

Then in John 20:19-22, after Jesus died and rose, he showed back up and revealed Himself to the disciples and reminded them what He said before He died. At this point, the disciples were afraid and worried after Jesus was put to death because the Jewish leaders were coming after them, but

that is is when Jesus showed up and reminded them He would be back. He reminded them in these verses about peace, saying, "Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you. "And with that he breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit."

The Holy Spirit is the key to our peace. We look for peace everywhere but for where it is. It's already in us. If you are a believer, you have the Holy Spirit and the Holy Spirit equals Peace. We must activate it like we do a new debit card or credit card and start using it. It works! And has ALL the power authority we need. Peace is ours today if you want it! All we need to do is tap into the promise of the Holy Spirit in us and cash in on the promise God already made to us and watch Him work peace in your soul!

There is nothing that the world can give that can replace or even compare to this peace Jesus has left for us. We look for peace in so many things except from the one who can give us everlasting peace. We look for it in money, jobs, people, activities, yoga, exercise to fill that void that is actually already in you as believers. Peace is at our fingertips, so ask God for it today and you will instantly feel the Holy Spirit blanket your soul with God's everlasting peace. It is always available to us as believers!
