# **QUARTERLY MESSAGE**

On Sunday, May 22, the Zion Baptist Church Family celebrated 14 high school seniors graduating from various Cobb County High Schools and getting ready to commence life as young-adults.

Some will be leaving home to attend various colleges, which means for the first time in their lives, they will no longer be under the daily guidance of their parents. Although this is a very happy time for these graduating seniors, it can be a very stressful and difficult time for their parents. But all their parents can do is trust that what they have instilled in these young adults for the past 17 to 18 years, will serve to lead, guide, and protect them, and help them to continue to make intelligent, thoughtful, and Christ-like decisions as they embark upon this new phase in life.

These 14 graduates also grew up connected to the spiritual nourishment of the Zion Baptist Church Family, where they have been able to form a spiritual relationship with Jesus Christ, who has informed us in the Gospel of John, that He is "The True Vine" (Jn. 15:1). So now is the time when all that has been poured into these graduates is put to the test and the final advise I want to give them as they commence upon this next chapter in their lives is simply - "stay connected to Jesus Christ - The True Vine". He is the vine and you are the branches that bear fruit - and if you do not stay connected, then you do not bear fruit, and Jesus says, you will wither (Jn: 15:2).

We are living in some uncertain times where every day our young people are confronted with rising gas and food costs, the cost of attending college has exploded, mass shootings are happening in places that were once deemed to be safe houses, such as our churches, schools, grocery stores, shopping centers, movie theatres, to name a few. This adds to the stress that not only our young people face, but their parents face as they try to let go enough to allow them to grow and mature, while fighting back the desire to keep them as close as possible to protect them from these dangers. So today, I want to use Jesus' teaching found in the Gospel of John, Chapter 15 to encourage our young people and hopefully bring some comfort to the parents as well.

When we turn to The Gospel of John, Chapter 15, we find Jesus preparing His disciples for His departure. He wanted them to know that He would always be connected to them spiritually and would never, ever abandon them. However, for this connectiveness to continue, they would have to do their part by staying connected to Him and His teachings through constant prayer and worship. Jesus' disciples represented the fruit produced from His ministry while He was with them. What they did, how they behaved and the decisions they were to make after His departure would be representative of their continued connectiveness to Him. You see, all fruit separates from the vine once its time of ripeness and maturity arrives, and the condition of that fruit depends upon how well it has been nurtured when it was connected

to the vine. Jesus had nurtured His disciples very well through His teachings and examples - just as our young adults and graduates have been nurtured and taught at Zion.

As young adults of Zion, you have received the best spiritual nurturing possible. Now, it is up to you to remain connected to The True Vine - Jesus Christ, by executing all that has been instilled in you by your parents and your Zion Baptist Church family. In closing, I would like to share three simple actions you can take as you venture into adulthood to make sure you stay connected to your faith and spiritual teachings no matter where life is about to take you.

- 1.If you are leaving home and relocating to another city or state, immediately, find a strong bible-based Baptist church with a biblically sound preaching and teaching Pastor, who believes in a strong and vibrant youth ministry.
- 2. Whether you are relocating or not, continue to attend worship services regularly; stay or get involved in the youth ministries, small groups, bible study, prayer services and Sunday School.
- 3. Continue to allow the Holy Spirit to use you to produce the fruits of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22-23) so that you draw other young people around you to Christ, instead of allowing them to draw you away from Christ.

Remember, Jesus told His disciples in John 15 that He is the True Vine and without Him they could do nothing. His words are still true today. So, stay connected to Jesus Christ -The True Vine so that you will continue to receive the spiritual nurturing you need to help you travel into full adulthood. Let nothing separate you from your faith and knowledge of Jesus - keep your relationship with Jesus strong and allow the Holy Spirit to always be your guide. Never forget what your parents and your Zion Family have instilled in you and you will make it through this next phase of life just fine!
